<b>Jaune Flamme</b> - apricot-colored 4 oz. fruit on elongated trusses; excellent fruity flavor, both sweet and tart; good dried, roasted	70-80	I	S

<b>Pineapple</b> - 1 lb. red/yellow streaked, meaty beefsteak; fewer seeds; old-fashioned, full-bodied tomato flavor; fruity aftertaste	90	I	S
<b>Pink Berkeley Tie-Dye</b> - 8-12 oz. wine-colored beefsteak w/ metallic green stripes; very sweet, rich, well-balanced, dark tomato flavor	65-75	I	S

<b>Opalka</b> - 3 x 5" red paste tomato; excellent flavor; few seeds; fruit holds well on vine; perfect for processing	85	I	H S
<b>Pink Honey</b> - 10-16 oz. red oxheart shaped; delicious, rich, sweet, fruity taste; very meaty, few seeds; does well in cooler weather; hi yields	72	I	H E

<b>Matt's Wild Cherry</b> - 3/4" deep red, round fruits; sweet, full flavor with high sugar content; superior taste; great fresh, salsa	60	I	H E
<b>Napa Grape</b> - elongated, shiny, red 1" 1 oz. globes; higher sugar content than any other grape tomato; productive, vigorous plants	65	I	HY E C
<b>Princess Yum Yum</b> - .5 oz. 1.5 x 1" brilliant red fruits grow in clusters; one of the highest in sugar content; grape-shaped	78	I	Hy R
<b>Sunchocola</b> - 1 oz. 1" chocolate-red cherry w/ exceptionally sweet, smoky flavored, juicy fruit; clusters of 8-12; low acid, hi sugar; productive	60-65	I	Hy R
<b>Sungold</b> - 1 1/4" bright apricot-orange cherry borne on trusses of 10-15 fruits; exceptionally sweet, fruity flavor; very high yields	60	I	Hy E
<b>Sungreen Garden</b> - 1/2-3/4 oz. bite-sized lime green fruit; absolutely delicious, sweet w/tangy kick; ripe when soft to touch; grows in clusters	65-70	I	Hy R

<b>Sweet Aperitif</b> - .5 oz. 7/8" red fruits on triple trusses; sweetest cherry - 13 brix, more than sungold! delicious, complex taste; crack-resistant	80	I	Hy
<b>Valentine PSU</b> - .4 oz. deep red grape w/ unusually rich, sweet flavor; crack-resistant; meaty; high lycopene; massive yields; AAS winner!	55	I	Hy E R
<b>Verona</b> - 2 1/2 oz. deep red grape; larger, more flavorful than Juliet; plump cocktail plum grows on long clusters; DR, high yields	69	I	Hy E R

<b>Glacier</b> - 2-3 oz. orangey-red fruit; surprisingly sweet yet rich; most flavorful early tomato; sets fruit well even in cool weather	55	D	H SD
<b>Jetsetter</b> - 8 oz. red, juicy, smooth, flattened globes w/ sweet, rich, nicely balanced, old-fashioned flavor; huge yields	64	I	Hy S R
<b>Pink Passion</b> - 4-7 oz. heart-shaped pink fruits with delicately balanced, fruity, sweet flavor; small seed cavity; prolific; dwarf plant - 3'	67	D	S OP C
<b>Stupice</b> - 2" red fruit in clusters; great flavor; heavy yields all season; produces well in northern climates; potato leaf; compact plant	55-70	I	H S C

### Other

<b>Goldie Ground Cherry</b> - 1/2-3/4" cherry-sized fruit in husks; sweet, tropical-tasting golden berries with hint of strawberry-pineapple; jam, jelly	70	I	H
<b>Purple Tomatillo</b> - 2-4 oz. fruit ripens to rich purple inside papery husk; sweet, tart; excellent for salsa verde, Mexican dishes; prolific	70	I	H T
<b>Toma Verde Tomatillo</b> - round, green, medium to large fruit; sweet yet tart; sweeter as they ripen; high yields; salsa, Mexican dishes	60-75	s-D	T
